Since universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the machinery and are much less at risk to damage. These buckets are even 50 percent deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra room makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for instance tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.
